

Steps to Present the Gospel

1. Cover the 3 H's - Home, Habit, Heaven
2. The personal talk and introduction to the gospel:
 - A) Do you know for certain that if you were to die right now that you would go to heaven?
 - If they say yes ask Why they think they would.
 - if they answer anything other than I committed my life to Jesus, such as works answers then point them to Ephesians 2:8-9 and go to # 3
 - if they say no or I don't know then go to # 3
 - B) Or ask "If you were to die and face God right now and He asked why He should let you into His kingdom what would you say?"
 - If they answer anything other than I committed my life to Jesus, such as works answers then point the to Ephesians 2:8-9 and go to # 3
For either question if they indicate that they have committed their life to Jesus then ask (for clarification)
 - When they committed their life to Jesus. They do not have to know the date, but they should be able to give the significant point in there life such as whether it was at home, church, etc. and how.
3. The Biblical explanation of salvation:
 - The Bible says in Romans 3:23
 - "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God."
 - That simply means that everyone has committed sin. That I'm a sinner and you also are a sinner.
 - The Bible also tells us the price for sin. Romans 6:23a
 - "The wages of sin is death."
 - Wages is what we earn, like if you worked at McDonalds you would earn a wage'(\$\$). The wages, what we earn from sin is death, which means eternity in hell.
 - Now I know you don't want to end up in a place of eternal torment and God never wanted man-to spend an eternity in hell. God loves you so much. John 3:16
 - Romans 6:23b goes on to say
 - "But the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
 - Now a gift is something you don't earn or buy but something given freely.
 - The Bible tells us there is nothing we can do within ourselves to earn entrance to heaven.

In EPHESIANS 2:8,9 • It says,

"For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves;' it is a gift of God: Not of works. lest any man should boast."

So you see you and I cannot buy or be good -enough to gain entrance to Heaven. – Romans 3:23

The Bible says in ROMANS 5: 8,

“But God commendeth his love- toward us. in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us.”

He paid our price for sin and gave his life that you might have the free gift of Heaven.

Would you like to accept his free gift of salvation as he says in Romans 10: 13

- “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”
 - The verse simply means this:
 - The whosoever is anyone.
 - To call upon his name is to ask for forgiveness.
 - And he said if you did that you would be saved.
 - Saved means forgiveness of sin and made a child of God.

3. Decision

I want to ask you the most important question an individual can be asked. Would you be willing to turn your life around, confess and repent of sin and ask Jesus Christ to save you and forgive you of that sin?
